the petitioner and Mr. Ram Sevak Choudhary, the learned APP

for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in
connection with Bhagwanpur P. S. Case No.246 of 2020,
instituted for the offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

In view of the recovery of 45 litres of liquor from the
fodder house situated in the orchard belonging to the petitioner,
I am not inclined to accord the privilege of anticipatory bail to
him.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is
rejected.



However, if the petitioner surrenders before the Court below and seeks bail, the Court below shall consider the case on its own merits, without being prejudiced by the fact that the present anticipatory bail application has not been entertained by this Court.
