**ORAL ORDER**

(The proceedings of the Court are being conducted through Video  
Conferencing and the Advocates joined the proceedings through Video  
Conferencing from their residence.)

2      26-04-2021      The defect(s) as pointed out by the Office be removed by  
the learned counsel for the petitioner within two months after  
the High Court resumes its normal functioning.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences  
punishable under Sections 341, 342, 323, 120 B, 498A, 504 of  
the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of D.P. Act.

There is allegation of demand of dowry as well as torture  
against all the FIR named accused persons including the  
petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that  
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner  
is husband of the informant and is ready to keep her with full  
dignity and honour Petitioner carries criminal antecedent of two



cases in which he has been granted bail. Petitioner is in custody since 05.09.2020.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending, in connection with Mirganj P.S. Case No. 127 of 2020, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the court below.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
