- 3 06-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Bagengola P.S. Case No. 72 of 2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 379, 504 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. There is case and counter case between the parties. Both the parties have sustained injuries in the alleged occurrence. Further he contended that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-I, Buxar in connection with Bagengola P.S. Case No. 72 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
