ORAL ORDER

(The proceedings of the Court are being conducted through Video Conferencing and the Advocates joined the proceedings through Video Conferencing from their residence.)

2 16-04-2021 The defect (s) as pointed out by the Office be removed by the learned counsel for the petitioner within two months after High Court resumes its normal functioning.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 379, 411, 413 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant has alleged that on 21.08.2020 at 9:00 am when he went to buy fish at local market, a boy about 16 years old took his mobile from his pocket. Thereafter, the apprehended person disclosed his name and also disclosed that his associate is also in the market. He disclosed that Pawan



Singh uses him and his associate for the purpose of theft. Pawan Singh has dropped him and his associate in the market by Scorpio and a bike and petitioner is alleged to be driver of the said Scorpio vehicle.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case merely on suspicion. It is further submitted that petitioner is driver of the said vehicle which is plied on hire and pay basis and he has no concern with the co-accused persons. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 23.08.2020.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Purnea Sadar (Mufassil) P.S. Case No.300 of 2020, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as



directed by the Court and his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the court below.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
