ORAL ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that while passing the order on injunction matter, the District



Judge, Katihar in Civil Misc. Appeal No.18/2017 under order dated 30.07.2019 has directed the Sub Judge-I, Katihar to expedite the trial of the suit, preferably within a period of one year and both the parties were directed by the learned District Judge to co-operate in the trial, but still that suit is pending in the court of Sub Judge-I, Katihar.

Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, the learned Sub Judge-I Katihar, is directed to take every endeavour to dispose of the Title Suit No. 166/2016 within a period of six months, subject to legal or procedural impediment, if any.

With this direction/observation, this Civil Misc. petition is disposed of.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioners within the stipulated time provided in para 1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
