This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Isuapur Police Station Case No. 40 of 2020,
disclosing offences under Sections 420 and 409 of the Indian
Penal Code.

In view of the various orders passed by this Court
and statements of the petitioner is similarly situated and the
allegation are same and similar. It is also submitted by learned
counsel for the petitioner that he is not involved in the alleged
defalcation.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the application is
allowed.

Let the petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-IX, Chapra, Saran, in connection with Isuapur Police Station Case No. 40 of 2020, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure
