Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

That the present writ application is being filed
for challenging the order dated 05.07.2001
passed by Learned S.D.O. Sadar Sitamarhi
whereby and whereunder the PDS license of
the petitioner being License no. 18/1993 for
carried out a business of a Public Distribution
shop within the village-Parwaha, Block-
Parihar, District Sitamarhi was cancelled on
the ground that the show cause filed by the
petitioner is not satisfactory.



After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition, reserving liberty to file an appeal before the appropriate authority.

Prayer allowed.

He may do so within a period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the State states that if any such appeal is preferred by the petitioner within the aforesaid period, limitation shall not come in the way and the appeal shall be heard on merits, to be decided within a period of three months from the date of its filing.

We only hope and expect the appropriate authority to consider and decide the appeal on its own merit and with reasonable dispatch.

We clarify that we have not expressed any opinion on facts and law. All issues are left open.

Learned counsel for the parties undertake not to take any unnecessary adjournment in such proceedings.

The present petition stands disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand



disposed of.
