Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 95/2020, registered for the offences under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has two minor children and the petitioner, his two children and his mother-in-law are living together.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served if the petitioner is sent to jail. Accordingly, this bail application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his



arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 95 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
