Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Charpokhari P.S. Case No. 155 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 504, 323, 324, 307 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Considering the fact that the allegations against these petitioners are general and omnibus and there is case and counter case from both the sides, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara, in connection with Charpokhari P.S. Case No. 115 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
