Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 138 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 308, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 are the sons of petitioner no.3 and petitioner no.3 is the father of the informant and due to family dispute this occurrence is said to have been taken place.



Considering the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Xth, Gaya, in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 138 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
