This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Saharghat P.S. Case No. 85 of 2019 for the offence punishable under Sections 457, 341, 323, 324, 307, 337/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this bail application on behalf of



petitioner nos. 1 and 2.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn as against petitioner nos.1 and 2, above named.

Since petitioner nos. 3, 4 and 5 are ladies, their application for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. Let the petitioner nos. 3, 4 and 5, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., II, Benipatti, Madhubani, in connection with Saharghat P.S. Case No. 85 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
