Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Jandaha P.S. Case No. 05 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 328 and 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the fact that the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 are brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the deceased and petitioner no.3 is 77 years old mother-in-law of the deceased, this anticipatory bail application is also allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Hajipur, District- Vaishali, in connection with Jandaha P.S. Case No. 05 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
