2 03-11-2021 Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceeding. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Lutua P.S. Case No.06/2020, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 307, 120(B), 124(A), 121, 122 of the IPC and section 27 of the Arms Act and sections 16, 18, 20 of the U.A.P. Act.

Earlier, the prayer for bail of this petitioner was rejected on merit vide order dated 06.04.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No.1411 of 2021 by this Court.



The petitioner has now filed this application for bail.

Having gone through the submissions of the parties and on perusal of the bail application, I find that there is no new ground taken by the petitioner for grant of bail, as such, the prayer for bail is rejected.

Accordingly, the instant bail application is dismissed.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial.
