ORAL ORDER

2 17-11-2021 Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks
after complete start of the physical Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections
147/148/149/341/323/392/353 of the Indian Penal Code and
Sections 30(a)/41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

From a four wheeler huge quantity of liquor was
recovered and the person on the vehicle allegedly fled away.
The petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal
antecedent.

Submission is that neither the vehicle is of the



petitioner nor the petitioner has any concern with the said liquor.

Considering the fact that there is no direct material on the petitioner's involvement in the act alleged, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Muzaffarpur Sadar P.S. Case No.411 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
