That this Writ Application is being filed to quash/set aside
the order dated 26/8/2021 passed by Recovery Officer Debt
Recovery Tribunal Patna in R.P. Case No.15/2016 which
has been wrongly, illegally passed for auction sale of
property and the said illegal order for auction sale
obtained by Bank (Respondent No.1 & 2) by playing fraud
upon the court by suppression of real facts and without



filing the fresh valuation report as order of Learned Recovery Officer vide order dated 30/7/2021 and without considering the objection of the petitioner behind the back of petitioner and also to quash the final order passed in O.A No.106/2014 passed by P.O of D.R.T dated 7/1/2016 which has been obtain by Respondent No.1 & 2/Bank behind the back of petitioner exparte without proper consideration of material.
