This application for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Bypass P.S. Case No. 362 of 2020 registered for the
offence under Sections 272, 273, 290, 354(D), 420, 504, 506, 34
of the Indian Penal Code, section 3/4 of Bihar Bengal Gambling
Act and section 37 (b) (c) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act,
2018.

In view of the fact that *prima facie* a case under the
Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable
in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case



of Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019(2)
P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
