ORAL ORDER

6 24-02-2021 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“i) To direct the authorities to produce the entire documents related to assessment years 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 and upon production of the same, issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents authorities to refund excess amount of Rs.3,49,810/- (Rs. Three Lakh Forty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ten Rupees) for the assessment years 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 or alternatively, To direct the authorities to adjust the excess amount in any assessment



proceeding.

ii) To issue direction to the respondent authorities for payment of interest admissible for the delayed payment on the excess amount of Rs. 3,49,810/- for the assessment years 1999-2000 and 2000-2001.

iii) To any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition for the reason that with the passage of time the grievances of the petitioner stand redressed.

Petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
