counsel for the State via video conferencing.

This application has been filed for restoration of
Cr.WJC No.460 of 2017 which was dismissed for want of
prosecution on 31st July, 2019.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that on 31st July, 2019, while Cr.WJC No.460 of 2017
was called out, he was arguing another matter before another
