Learned counsel for the Accountant General very fairly submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed. He also submits that the petitioner may be given liberty to file a representation before the concerned authority for redressal of his grievances, if any.

representation before the concerned authority for redressal of his grievances, if any, and the concerned authority would be obliged to dispose of the same within a period of thirty days in accordance with law.

It is made clear that the concerned authority would be personally liable for non-compliance of this order.
