APP for the State.

The alleged allegation is related to 02.02.2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 376 and 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

In the instant case, petitioners have prayed for anticipatory bail. On 08.08.2019, interim order was passed in granting interim protection. Petitioners had interim protection for the last two years.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that parties have amicably settled, therefore, the present petition do not survive for consideration. Therefore, petition stands disposed of in the light of the aforesaid development in the matter. Reserving liberty to the



petitioners that in the event of settlement is not given effect, they shall move for bail before the jurisdiction court. The jurisdiction court is hereby directed to decide the bail of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of such bail petition.

In the meanwhile, no precipitative action shall be taken against the petitioners in connection with Complaint Case No. 292 of 2018, pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M. Vth, Katihar.
