ORAL ORDER

7 03-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 2447(C)/2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A/323/313/406/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is of demand of dowry and torture.

The Advocate for the opposite party No. 2 Shri Ansul on instruction submits that both the parties are living together



peacefully after the matter has been settled.

The aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the opposite party No. 2 has also been accepted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In order to verify the conduct of the petitioner, the petitioner is granted **provisional anticipatory bail** for three months.

Let the petitioner above named be released on **provisional bail**, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Araria, in connection with Complaint Case No. 2447(C)/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

Learned court below is directed to confirm the **provisional anticipatory bail** of the petitioner after three months on verifying the conduct of the petitioner with regard to maintaining good relationship with the opposite party No. 2 as they are presently living together.

If the opposite party No. 2 has any genuine grievance against the petitioner, then the provisional bail shall be



cancelled.

With the above directions, the present application for anticipatory bail is disposed of.
