ORAL ORDER

4 26-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, four unknown motorcycle borne miscreants fired upon the supervisor of the Highways construction company as a result of which he sustained injuries on his stomach, hands and thigh and died during treatment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. Petitioner's name has figured during course of investigation. He is in custody since 13.1.2013. Charge sheet has already been submitted.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature of allegation and charge sheet has already been



submitted, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge I, Sitamarhi in Runnisaipur Police Station Case No. 130 of 2012.
