The petitioner is in custody in connection with Chandi
P.S. Case No. 130 of 2018 (S.T. No. 525 of 2018) for the
offence under Section 302 and other allied Sections of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2018.

It appears from the report dated 10.01.2020 submitted
by the Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Hilsa, Nalanda that the
trial of the case is at the final stage, but the trial has not been
