ORAL ORDER

2 07-01-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the respondents.

The petitioner has approached this Court for setting
aside the order contained in memo no. 460 dated 31.08.2018
passed by the learned Sub-Divisional Officer, Madhubani by
which the PDS License of the petitioner has been cancelled.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that
his license has been cancelled by a non-speaking order and that
too without considering the show cause filed by him. After some
arguments, he seeks liberty to file a fresh representation before
the Sub-Divisional Officer, Madhubani.

Without going into the merits of the case, this writ



application is disposed off with a direction to respondent no. 3-
the Sub- Divisional Officer, Madhubani that if the petitioner
files a fresh representation along with a copy of this order
before him, the same shall be considered and he would pass a
reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months
from the date of filing of the representation.

It is made clear that respondent no. 3 would be solely
responsible for non-compliance of this order within the
stipulated period.

With the aforesaid direction, this writ application
stands disposed off.
