5 03-12-2021 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and

the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection

with Complaint Case No. 2556 of 2018 registered for the

offence punishable under sections 498, 323/34 of the Indian

Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner

submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this

case. It is further submitted that the complainant has

solemnized second marriage with one Shyam Bharti and is

not residing with him. A supplementary affidavit to that

effect has been filed, which is at Flag-C. Petitioner has no

criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, XIV, Saran at Chapra in connection with Complaint Case No. 2556 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
