6 28-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case no. 374 of 2018 instituted for the offence
under Sections 498A, 323, 379 and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner along with his
family members has tortured in various ways due to non-
fulfillment of dowry demand and finally they ousted her from
matrimonial home after snatching her belongings.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner



has submitted that petitioner is husband of the informant and has been falsely implicated in this case. He has never demanded any thing from the informant. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer of bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the submission made on behalf of the petitioner that he is ready to keep his wife, this Court is inclined to enlarge him on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Complaint Case no. 374 of 2018 he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Benipatti, Madhubani subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
