3 04-10-2021 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and

the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 467 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 506, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. The injuries sustained have been found to be simple in nature. Moreover, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a joint petition to that effect has



also been filed before the court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Araria. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Araia in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 467 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
