A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Mahila (Laheriasari) P.S. Case No. 26 of 2019 registered under Sections 323, 420, 498A and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that the first information report is lodged against the petitioner after a lapse of one month. Petitioner is ready and willing to keep his wife and children with him with full honour and dignity.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the

case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga in connection with Mahila (Laheriasari) P.S. Case No. 26 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
