ORAL ORDER

- 3 23-02-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P. for the State and senior counsel for the opposite party no. 2.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case for the offence registered under Sections 498(A), 304(B) and 120(B) of the I.P.C.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the accused persons including the petitioner killed the daughter of the informant due to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged



against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. She is separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased. She has got no concern with the alleged occurrence. The husband of the deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the State and opposite party no. 2, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-XII, Saran, in connection with Derni P.S. Case No. 165/19, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
