It is submitted by the learned counsel for the State that a report has been prepared by the Inspector-in-Charge, Bankura Sadar Police Station dated June 22, 2021.

It is further submitted by Mr. De, learned counsel for the State that a police constable has been posted outside the house of the petitioners.

This Court appreciates the prompt action on the part of the Bankura Sadar Police Station.

Counsel for the petitioners confirms that the writ petitioners have been restored into their house and are, in fact, residing there.

Counsel for the private respondent no. 5 submits by way of an application that his parents want to stay with him.

This Court cannot enter into the dispute any further under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. However, the Inspector-in-Charge, Bankura Sadar Police Station may take suitable steps in accordance with law after making due enquiry based on the letter dated June 19, 2021.

With the aforesaid observations, the instant writ petition and the connected application are disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
