Entry Operator with the District Horticulture Officer,
Purba Bardhaman under the Directorate of
Horticulture.

dated 16th October, 2020 issued by the Department of
Personnel & Administrative Reforms (e-Governance
Cell). He further submits that the petitioner's services
have been terminated by an order dated 2nd December,
2020. He has made a representation against the same
on 12th December, 2020 and 14th December, 2020.

In those circumstances, the respondent no.4
shall consider the petitioner's representation dated
12th December, 2020 and 14th December, 2020 within

a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

Any order that may be passed by the respondent on.4 to be communicated to the petitioner within ten days thereof.

With the aforesaid directions, the instant writ petition shall stand disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
