In Re: An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in connection with an order dated 22.12.2020 passed by the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, 2nd Court, under POCSO Act, Howrah, thereby rejecting the prayer for bail of the petitioner in connection with A.J.C. Bose B Garden Police Station Case No.204 of 2020 dated 04.12.2020 registered for investigation into the offences punishable under Sections 498A/406/354/120B of the Indian Penal Code and 8 & 12 of the POCSO Act.

The petitioner is the husband of the de facto complainant. Having heard the learned Advocate for the petitioner and the learned P.P.-in-Charge, it is ascertained that allegation has been made against the petitioner under Section 498A/323 of the Indian Penal Code. There are other allegations made by the de facto complainant against other matrimonial relations, which do not attract

against the present petitioner. He is in custody for 38 days.

Considering the period of detention and stage of investigation, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is granted bail of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each of like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, POCSO Court, Howrah and on further condition that during trial, the petitioner must be present in Court on all occasions, failing which the order of bail shall be cancelled without further reference to this Court.

C.D. be returned.
