The college authorities are requested to allow the petitioner to participate in the College Mop up round in M.B.B.S. admission, if the petitioner is

otherwise eligible for selection and the petitioner's admission will be subject to his merit position.

The writ petition being WPA 963 of 2021 is accordingly disposed of.

Since no affidavits have been invited, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied.
