The respondent no.3 in compliance with the order passed by this court on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2021 read with the order passed on 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 has paid the petitioner second and final installment amounting to Rs. 4,41,500/- (Four Lakh Forty One Thousand Five Hundred Only) which the petitioner has received as has been submitted by Mr. Anant Shaw, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner.
