This revisional application has been filed by the petitioners/respondents praying for expeditious disposal of the Title Appeal No.105 of 2010, which is pending for final hearing. The appeal has been preferred against the judgment and decree dated March 19, 2010 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 1st Court at Chandernagore, Hooghly.
