Having considered materials in the case diary disclosing prima facie involvement of petitioner no. 1 in the alleged crime, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.

However, bearing in mind the extent of complicity of petitioner nos. 2, 3 and 4 in the alleged crime and the gravity of the injury suffered by the victim, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner nos. 2, 3 and 4.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner nos. 2, 3 and 4 shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application being CRM 1022 of 2021 is disposed of.
