This is an application seeking an expeditious disposal of a case in which a charge-sheet was submitted under Section 21 (c) of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits as follows. The petitioner is in custody in connection with this case since October, 2019. Although a charge-sheet was submitted in 2019 and a supplementary charge-sheet was also submitted in 2020, till date, even the charges could not be framed. Long dates are being fixed. The matter has remained pending for no fault of the present petitioner.

I have heard the submissions of the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the State and have perused the revision petition.

It appears that some delay has been occasioned in this case, especially considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody in connection with the case since October, 2019.

In view of the above and in the interest of justice, I request the learned trial Court to conclude the proceeding at the earliest without granting any unnecessary adjournment to any of the parties and decide the question of framing of charge at the earliest, preferably within three months from the next date of hearing.

With these observations, the revisional application is disposed of.
