It appears that despite endeavour made by the Court to bring the parties on record, none of them has turned up.

I have carefully read the judgment passed by the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate, Arambagh, Hooghly in C.R. Case 23 of 1985. By the judgment the respondents/accused persons were found not guilty of the offences punishable under Sections 323/504/427 of the Indian Penal Code and accordingly, the accused persons were acquitted of the offences as alleged.

What I perceive, the judgment of the learned Court below is based on proper appreciation of the evidence-on-record. I find no reason to interfere with the judgment passed by learned trial Judge as the judgment does not suffer from any illegality

In view of the above, the appeal is dismissed. The judgment passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arambagh, Hooghly in C.R. Case No. 23 of 1985 is confirmed.
