The petitioner has applied for revocation of a grant of probate giving rise to Misc. Case No. 69 of 2013 pending before the 5<sup>th</sup> Court of learned Additional District Judge at Barasat, District : 24 Parganas (North).

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court by an order dated August 06, 2018 passed in CO 2527 of 2018 has directed expeditious disposal of the said misc. case.

It appears from the order no. 56 dated December 21, 2020 that the learned Trial Judge in terms of such direction is taking appropriate steps for expeditious disposal of the said misc. case.
