The petitioners' grievance is that the private respondents are raising construction by encroaching the Government land and also by obstructing their egress and ingress. The petitioners filed a representation ventilating their grievance before the competent Authority on 23rd January, 2019, but such representation is yet to be disposed of. The petitioners pray for a direction upon the Authority to dispose of the said representation at the earliest.

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the parties and material on record, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction upon the 4th respondent to consider and dispose of the representation of the petitioners dated 23rd January, 2019 within a period of three months from the date of

communication of this order, after affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to the interested parties including the petitioners and the private respondents, in accordance with law.

W.P.A. 2369 of 2019 is thus disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, allegations contained in the writ petition shall be deemed not to have been admitted.
