Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the complaint is a product of political rivalry. There are counter cases also.

State is represented.

Considering the contents of the case diary and the omnibus allegations against the petitioners, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the

conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further conditions that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court on every date fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
