This is an application for anticipatory bail apprehending arrest in connection with Nandakumar P.S. Case No.119/2020 dated 26.3.2020 under Sections 186/188/269/270/271/353/332/333/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and under Section 9 of the M.P.O. Act.
