The present revisional application has been preferred against the order dated 30th November, 2012 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Malda in connection with a proceeding under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure wherein the learned Magistrate after taking into account the evidence adduced by both the parties was pleased to award Rs.1,500/- per month to the wife and Rs.1,500/- per month to the minor son as monthly maintenance allowance. By the same order the learned Magistrate was pleased to give effect to the said order of maintenance from 30th November, 2012.

Having regard to the reasons assigned by the learned Magistrate and the appreciation of evidence made by the said Court as also the quantum arrived at for awarding maintenance and also taking into account the expenses, no interference is called for by this Court.

Accordingly, C.R.R. 199 of 2013 is dismissed.

All pending applications, if any, are disposed of.

Interim order, if any, is hereby vacated.

The opposite party no.1 will be at liberty to regularize the arrears by taking out appropriate applications before the learned Judicial Magistrate.
