The Commissioner of School Education, (Primary Branch), Government of West Bengal is requested to give an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and to allow the petitioner to produce all the relevant documents at the time of hearing and to pass a reasoned order within twelve weeks from today. The Commissioner of School Education, (Primary Branch), Government of West Bengal is also requested to communicate the reasoned order to the petitioner at an earliest.

The writ petition being WPA 4646 of 2021 is accordingly disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavits have been invited, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied.
