We have perused the pleadings and the material papers in this writ petition. There is no appearance for the petitioner.

The issue sought to be raised is intricately connected with matters which were pending consideration by the criminal court. The allegations raised in the writ petition are those which lie intertwined with the criminal court proceedings. There were some matters before the West Bengal Human Rights Commission also.
