This is an application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India wherein the writ petitioner is aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the respondent authorities in disposing of the appeal, being No. 6412 of 2019 (A) (Arnab Jana Vs. West Bengal School Service Commission) by the second appellate authority, West Bengal Information Commission.

I have heard learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties and perused the materials placed on record.

In the light of the same, the Deputy Secretary, West Bengal Information Commission, being the respondent No. 6 is directed to hear out the appeal of the petitioner after granting an opportunity to the petitioner and thereafter, pass necessary reasoned order within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

The reasoned order should be communicated to petitioner within a week from the date of passing such reasoned order.

With the aforesaid observation the writ petition is disposed of.

Since, no affidavit-in-opposition has been called

for, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have not been admitted by the respondents.

There will be no order as to costs.
