It is submitted on behalf of the respondent nos. 2, 3 and 4 that the Group Insurance amount payable to the petitioner's husband has been paid to the petitioner. A cheque bearing no.620350 dated 11th November, 2021 for a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- has been deposited in the Account No.10574044597 standing in the name of the petitioner in State Bank of India. A photocopy of the letter stating about the deposit is made over to Court, which is taken on record.
