It is submitted that gratuity of the petitioner to
the extent of Rs.2,97,576.88 has been paid. In so far
as the petitioner's other terminal benefits are
concerned, particularly the provident fund, a suitable
decision and release of at least the petitioner's
contribution to provident fund shall be effected by the
Bank within a period of 45 days from date.

With the aforesaid directions, the instant writ
application shall stand disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
