The contempt application has been filed alleging violation of an order dated 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2004 passed in WP 21835 (W) of 2000. It appears that a Rule was issued on 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2005.

The matter appeared in the list on 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 and was called twice but no one appeared on behalf of the parties. Today the matter has been placed in the list marked as “Last Chance” with a note that appropriate orders will be passed if no one appears when the matter is taken up. Even today, no one appears on behalf of any of the parties. No one has also applied for joining in the virtual mode.
