The allegation is under Sections 498A/304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner is the wife of a cousin brother of the husband of the victim. She is one of the seven accused persons. Four accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court. The other two accused persons have been granted bail by the Court below.

We have considered the material in the case diary. It is not in dispute that the petitioner resided separately and not in the same house as the victim.

Considering the material on record and the facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the view that immediate custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be necessary so long as she cooperates with the Investigating Officer. Further, charge sheet has been submitted.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure until further orders.

In case the petitioner fails to adhere to any of the conditions mentioned in Section 438(2) of the Code, the learned Court below shall be entitled to cancel the anticipatory bail without further reference to this Court.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. No.2171 of 2021 is, thus, allowed.
